At the 78th Festival de Cannes, Projeto Paradiso will support a Brazilian feature film in the **Official Selection**, Kleber Mendonça Filho's *The Secret Agent*; as well as Pedro Pinho's *I Only Rest in the Storm*, in the **Un Certain Regard** selection; Leonardo Martinelli's short film *Samba Infinito* in the **Semaine de la Critique** selection; Lírio Ferreira and Karen Harley's *To Vigo I Go!*, in the **Cannes Classics**; and Aurélien Vernhes-Lermusiaux's *The Black Snake* in the **ACID** section.

As the neo-colonial dynamics among the expatriate community unravel, this fragile bond becomes his only refuge from an impending collapse into solitude or barbarism.

In a landmark moment for Brazilian cinema, the nation takes centre stage as the Marché du Film's 2025 **Country of Honour**.

Brazil's participation will be organized jointly by the Ministry of Culture and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and will include filmmakers, producers, and representatives of the Brazilian audiovisual industry. It will provide an opportunity to establish partnerships and **promote Brazilian cinema** on the global stage.

Brazil's presence at the Marché du Film is part of the Saison France-Brésil de l'Institut Français, which will include a series of cultural and academic events in both countries, aimed at **strengthening ties between the two nations**.

Adding to Brazil's vibrant presence, three of the country's **leading film institutions** will use their stands as vital hubs to promote Brazilian cinema and foster international partnerships throughout the market: **Cinema do Brasil** (Palais-1, nº 26.01), **Spcine** (Palais-1, nº 25.01) and **RioFilme** (Palais-1, nº23.02).

Its objective is to promote international co-productions of high artistic value and foster the professional skill-building of participants – independent and debut screenwriters, directors, and producers.

We Are Not Dreaming, directed by Ulisses Arthur, a feature project developed during Paradiso Incubator 2020, was selected for Marché du Film's section Festival do Rio Goes to Cannes, where it will be able to pitch its creative visions and connect with potential sales agents, distributors, and international festival programmers.

Four short films produced as part of the **Directors' Factory Ceará Brasil** project will open the Directors' Fortnight, one of the festival's most prestigious film selection. Sponsored by the Government of Ceará in partnership with the Directors' Fortnight and curated by Ceará-born filmmaker Karim Aïnouz, the initiative pairs four professionals from Brazil's North and Northeast regions with four international counterparts.
